Hope for the Future

The First readings in the Advent chiefly from the book of Isaiah, confirm and express our hope in God's involvement in the future: "He shall judge between the nations, and impose terms on many peoples. They shall beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks: (Is 2:4, First Sunday of Advent). A shoot shall sprout from the stump of Jesse, and from his roots a bud shall blossom: (Is 11:1 Second Sunday). "Say to those whose hearts are frightened: Be strong, do not fear! Here is your God, he comes with vindication; with divine recompense he comes to save you" (Is 25:4, Third Sunday). "The virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall name him Emmanuel (Is 7:14, Fourth Sunday). All point to the coming and the reign of the Messiah and God.

Indeed, the Church is in crisis. However, as long as we recognize God as creator and sovereign ruler, as long as we see God's glorious presence in the worked and seriously discern the mystery and transcendence of God, as long as we recognize the fullness of God's solidarity with those who suffer, we have a future.
